VPO Welcomes Guest Performers For Upcoming Show

Its first classical concert of 2025 is at 7 p.m. Sunday at The Sharon L. Morse Performing Arts Center.

The Villages Philharmonic Orchestra's first classical concert of the year will feature two guest artists.

Italian conductor and guest pianist Renato Balsadonna and violinist Laura Hamilton will join the orchestra to perform a program of timeless masterpieces by composers Benjamin Britten, Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart and Ludwig van Beethoven. The concert also marks Balsadonna's first performance in The Villages.

Mozart composed 27 piano concertos, and only two among them are in minor key. The "Piano Concerto No. 20 in D minor, K. 466" is one of those two.

For an audience not knowledgeable on music theory, as well as "The Magic Flute." "This piano concert leans more toward dramatism, with very strong contrasts,' Balsadonna said. "This piano concerto is so profound, so deep that no matter how many times you play it, you always find something more, something you can do better."
